



The Italian Alpine Club has long been committed to promoting an environmentally sustainable development in relation to the attendance of the mountain, also reducing the environmental impact resulting from the presence of mountain huts that it manages. Therefore, in the awareness of the growing environmental sensitivity of the mountaineering world, and of the instances of which this world is the bearer, will embrace the principles of environmental management of the mountain huts and will work to identify targets for environmental improvement, to organize and find financial funds to finance the necessary actions to achieve them, with a view to continuous improvement.

Headquarters and the Section of Varallo of the Italian Alpine Club, respectively the owner and manager of the mountain hut called Regina Margherita located in P. Gnifetti undertake, both for their competence, to maintain compliance with the law, through a management structure in compliance with applicable legal requirements and other requirements regarding its environmental aspects.


They undertake, in addition,

- monitoring of more significant environmental variables (fuel consumption, water consumption, waste production, organic waste) in order to have quantitative information that allow to evaluate, over time, the actual achievement of objectives and improvement efficiency in the management of the mountain huts;
- to adopt measures to prevent and reduce the quantities of waste produced at the mountain hut;
- the maintenance of a system of separate collection of solid waste;
- disposal of organic wastes by providing transport and delivery in a dedicated area;
- to encourage the introduction of systems that promote the optimization of the management of energy consumption related to the management of the mountain hut;
- the adoption of measures that allow to optimize the management of water resources through waste reduction and rationalization of its uses;
- to communicate its commitment to environmental awareness among visitors of the mountain huts and all those who work within and on behalf of them.

We also propose to pursue pollution prevention, constantly improving the organization of the Regina Margherita hut and or its performance. The commitments identified will be pursued, regularly setting and reviewing objectives, targets and environmental programs, which derive from the commitments of Italian Alpine Club, Headquarters and Section of Varallo, each within its competence. Headquarters and the Section of the CAI Varallo undertake also to develop the human resources, scientific and financial resources, essential for the implementation and monitoring of the Environmental Management System. To implement this policy an Environmental Management System according to UNI EN ISO 14001:2004 has been defined, implemented and monitored.
